

Dolgeville Central School Student Snowmobile Registration

Riding a snowmobile to school is a privilege and not a right. Be safe and enjoy the outdoors.

Failure to follow any of the procedures listed below will result in the loss of riding privileges.

Snowmobiles must be registered and insured. All information must be completed below and submitted to Mrs. Winkler in the High School office along with a copy of your registration and insurance. Snowmobiles that are not properly registered and insured will be removed from school property at the owner's expense.

Snowmobiles must be parked next to the away team dug out on the girls' softball field.

Snowmobiles must be driven from the trail directly to where they will be parked.

Riding on the athletic fields, the school's sidewalks, or anywhere on school property other than a direct path from the trail to the parking area is strictly prohibited and will result in the loss of riding privileges.

Dolgeville Central School is not responsible for stolen or damaged snowmobiles. Dolgeville Central School is not responsible for any injuries that could occur while riding a snowmobile.
